After a 2.5-year break in May 2011 it was organized the expedition for the purpose of assessment Przhevalski's horse population in the Exclusion Zone. At the beginning of May 2011 the population was at least 60 individuals aged one year or older within the territory of the Chernobyl Exclusion zone. During the current year, the expected population growth will be from 15 to 25% due to the birth of young animals. For the prosperous existence of the Przhevalsky horse population is necessary not only the protection of animals from poaching, but also the protection of their habitats.
